**Opening:** The meeting was called to order by Sarah Thom at 7.09pm.

**Minutes:** Complete minutes were distributed to and reviewed by members via e-mail prior to the meeting. Gillian Dyall reviewed open items from April's minutes. The minutes were approved as submitted.

**Budget:** This year's budget is now at \$34,450 due to additional items voted on last month. We have spent \$18,977. Total assets are \$33,523 which now includes the credit card payments from the auction. The auction made almost \$21,000! Desirea Muraoka presented the budget report which was approved as read.

**Carnival:** Cathy Winkler, Janet Vanoni and Tina Schade are organising this event on June 2nd. Volunteer sign-ups and order forms for wristbands will come home. Wristbands will cost \$1 for Cedar Mill Students and \$5 for guests. Dinner will be hamburgers or gardenburgers. 5<sup>th</sup> graders will eat pie with no hands!

**School Dance:** The Sock Hop is scheduled for Friday May 19<sup>th</sup>. There will not be a poster contest but some will be made by the 5<sup>th</sup> graders. Taylor needs volunteers especially for security. Ken Berger is DJ and Linda Riley is photographer. 5<sup>th</sup> graders will sell bottled water. There will be ads in the quill and flyers coming home. Does anyone know where the sock hop decorations are? **2006-7 PTC Budget:** A list was presented of items similar to this years' budget and suggestions for changes were made. The budget committee will meet to compile a proposed budget for 2006-7 which will then be sent to everyone. It will be voted on at the June PTC meeting.

**Proposed Budget Additions:** The PTC voted to approve 5 items last month and there is around \$10,000 of extra money remaining. Items with estimated costs were listed and those present were each given 5 votes. The following were approved:
