

## **Cedar Mill PTC Minutes 9/7/06**

**Opening:** The meeting was called to order by Sarah Thom at 7:00pm. PTC board members were introduced.

**Bond Measure:** Priscilla Turner Beaverton School Board Member (Chair) and co-chair of bond campaign reported on Capital Bond Measure. In May the bond had majority support but failed to meet 50% voter turnout. Trying to get out message of capacity problems to voters. Bond will cost \$.51 per \$1000 of assessed value. Bond has changed due to inflation – Cedar Mill won't get office relocation. Cedar Park won't get restroom remodel. Sunset gets less money for plumbing. Developing McDaniel property for K-5 (2 stories instead of 3) to capacity of land=620 students. K-8 school on Bruger Road property. Teufel property: according to Scot Stockwell will be kindergarten annex, special programs. Next bond measure will fund building new school (probably middle school).

Bond Team: Scot Stockwell is team captain. Need volunteers to staff phone banks on Sept. 25 and Oct. 4; Pass out flyers at Beaverton Farmers Market on Sept. 30 and Cedar Mill Farmers Market on Oct. 7. Each school is asked to come up with \$500 in donations for campaign–yard signs, etc. can take tax credit–possible deduction – Scot will clarify in the “Quill.”

**Volunteer Orientation:** Laurie Maheu. Handbooks include: importance of name tags, computer use, confidentiality. Volunteer Restrooms in the health room and teachers' lounge. “Sign in computer” in office, Laurie will sign people in tonight Name tag sheet in office next to computer. Keep a sheet at home for hours logged in and out of school – override optional. Information submitted to state – helps with bonds measure to show strong support. Volunteers needed for: Back to School BBQ; Curriculum night – Babysitters also needed; picture day (Sept. 20); classroom coordinators

**Minutes:** Secretary Amy Corris couldn't be at the meeting. Approval of June minutes was tabled until next month.

**Budget Report:** This year's budget is \$34,960 which includes some carry-over items from last year. This year's operating budget is \$29,825. Total assets are currently \$16420.13. Desirea Muraoka presented the budget report which was approved as read. New Check Request Form: fill out and place in PTC Treasurer's Box in office

**Back-to-School BBQ:** Fri, Sept. 8 6-8pm. Hot dogs, chips, ice cream. Free event, donations welcome. Volunteers needed.

**Clothes Closet:** Kathy Hall – Clothes Closet is district-run “second-hand store” for students in need. Each school works one day a year – ours is September 27 Wednesday from 9-4. Volunteer sign-up sheet sent around. Donations of clothes can be left in school office or in bin outside Clothes Closet at BSD offices. Enclose SASE and you will be send tax receipt.

**Library Volunteers:** Sign up sheet sent around. Different library schedule this year.

**Enrichment:** classes ready to be offered 10/2-12/15: drawing/cartooning, French, Mad Science. Assemblies confirmed: Native American Intertribal 10/30 9 AM; Portland Taiko: Rock the Boat 2/9 1 PM; Tears of Joy Theatre: 4/23 9AM & 1 PM.

**Principal's Update:** PBS – Positive Behavior Support – teaching positive behaviors. Two times per month Gotcha store (items to be purchased in store) – or Gotchas can be entered into random drawings. Also – wooden nickels given out for positive behavior. Reward plans for X number of tokens. Remind children to place names on Gotchas to be drawn.

**Art Literacy:** Five artists and game highlighting artists. Presentation production – explanation of each need: two parents per classroom scheduled time – six times per year. Contact Colleen Lay, also on website

**Fundraising:** Sally Foster Fund Raising Sale, Sept. 15-Oct. 2, traditional or on-line order forms. Register for E-scrip: Safeway, Zupans, Whole Foods – % of purchase to school, grandparents can register in other states, money to PTC budget.
