A Note to Parents of the Players:

- Whether your child is outgoing or reserved, he/she will benefit from participating in drama. Shy children in particular often thrive in the theatre environment. This is a place where they can truly be themselves!
- The activities we offer apply to beginning and advanced students, presenting fresh challenges for all skill levels. Most classes are open to grades 1-5, unless otherwise noted. We separate groups into grade levels when possible.
- In addition to having a great deal of fun, we will be learning about the focus and discipline required of actors. It is our intention to be of maximum benefit to each student. We have clear and consistent class rules, and will give a courtesy call to a parent if there are persistent behavior problems. If a student continues to be disruptive, he/she may be excused **without** refund for the remainder of the workshops.
- Please send your child with a snack on the day he/she has acting class.
- The Young Players Acting Workshops focus on giving children an immediate positive experience of drama, not on rehearsing a scripted play. This removes any "performance anxiety," and allows the child greater freedom of expression. Students perform pieces for each other during every class. We are also available to help your school put on a play, if there are enough children interested in participating.
- We will return to the school every year. Returning students enhance their skills, and new students are welcome anytime.
- We are usually assigned a room just before the class begins, so please call the school if you are curious about where the workshop will be held.

The Young Players Policies:

- **Registration is automatic.** *We will not be calling to confirm your enrollment. Please assume that your child is enrolled once you send in the registration and payment. We will only contact you in the event that the class is full by the time we receive your registration, or in the event that the class does not fill. We do not issue refunds when parents forget to send their child to class so please make note of the class dates on your calendar.*
- Your school will receive a roster of the students who are taking drama, but we cannot guarantee that your child's teacher will be notified, or will remind your child to go to acting class. Please remind your child each time he/she has theatre after-school or send an e-mail to your child's teacher as a reminder. Young Players instructors arrive at the school before school lets out, and will stay until all children have been picked up, but we cannot assume responsibility for *getting your child* to the class.
- Discounts—We offer 10% off for the second registration for families where more than one sibling is taking the workshop.
- If your child will be picked up after Young Players Workshop, please meet him/her at the room location promptly at the end of class. For safety reasons, please be on time to pick up your child. We cannot leave children unattended, and our instructors may be required at another school following your workshop. If you are more than five minutes late, **we will charge a dollar a minute to stay and wait.**
- It is important to remember that only those listed on your original registration may pick up your child.
- We limit class size, therefore we offer refunds before the second class ONLY.
